Useful information

Arrival to Dresden Airport on Sunday, 15 May 2011

You may take any international or domestic flight to Dresden airport, which is located 18 km outside the city. From Dresden airport you can take the suburban railway (S-Bahn No. 2 with destination *Pirna*) from terminal 1, which costs approx. 2.- EUR. Please get off at Dresden main station (Hauptbahnhof Dresden). Then take a taxi from the main station to the hotel. You can also take a taxi from the airport directly to your hotel, which costs approx. 20.- EUR. No organised transportation will be available since the arrival times of each participant will be different. We suggest the cheapest form of transport which is the suburban railway. A taxi can also be taken.

Accommodation and meals

Accommodation will be arranged in single/shared twin rooms. The hotels in each city will offer breakfast in the morning. Lunches and coffees will be organised at each hospital during the day time.
