Useful information

Arrival to London Airports, on 09 October 2011

You may take any international or domestic flight to London Heathrow airport, Gatwick airport or London City airport.

London Heathrow Airport:

From London Heathrow airport the underground "Piccadilly line" goes directly to Russels Square station which is the nearest station to the hotel. If you wish to use the Heathrow Express you will arrive at Paddington and then you will need to use the "Metropolitan/Circle line" to Euston Square, which is the next closest underground station to the hotel.

Gatwick and London City airport:

If arriving via Gatwick or London City airport, please consult the London Underground Map.

You can also take a taxi from the airport directly to the hotel, which costs approximately £45.00. No organised transportation will be available since the arrival times of each participant will be different. We suggest the cheapest form of transport which is by underground or a taxi can also be taken.

Please be aware that the traffic drives on the left in Great Britain and you should take care crossing roads!
