#### Dear Colleagues,

You all know that the prevalence of periprosthetic fractures is increasing. They can occur during and after primary and – most frequently – revision surgery. Loosening and bone loss frequently complicate the fracture. These fractures are a challenge both in terms of replacement, and for the trauma surgeon.

We have been able to secure eminent speakers to give introductory lectures on the state of the art, but the course is based primarily on case discussions, so knowledge transfer will be multi-directional. The course is aimed at experienced orthopaedic and trauma surgeons who are keen to improve their knowledge, but also willing to share it.

New methods of extramedullary fixation have become the mainstay of stable implants and revision arthroplasty. Stems that hold beyond the fracture can solve the problem in many cases of loosened implants, but there is room for improvement, and new challenges are emerging in the form of interprosthetic fractures or upper extremity periprosthetic fractures.

The replacement, fixation and pharmaceutical sectors are important partners in these endeavours. There is a need for innovation in preventing fractures, new surgical implants that address specific problems, and post-operatory management for these difficult cases.

We invite you all to come to Barcelona in March 2012. We will do our utmost to offer a lively, interactive course where you can meet experts from all sides and share your difficult cases with them.


