

During the 20th century, the options for dealing with osteoarthritis evolved from resection arthroplasty and arthrodesis and from there to total joint arthroplasty. The value of joint preserving surgery (JPS) has been highlighted in the past, and deserves our attention once again when considering the importance of keeping autologous joint structures in order to achieve normal biomechanical function and propioception, as well as factors such as sporting activities, and the future potential use of osteochondral tissue engineering.
