### Useful information

### Arrival to Schiphol Airport, on 04 October 2015

You may take any international flight to Schiphol-Amsterdam airport, which is located 45 km outside Rotterdam, where the program will start.

From Schiphol-Amsterdam airport there is a direct train connection with Rotterdam. Schiphol railway station is situated directly below the airport. You can pick up a free baggage trolley from the platform. Via Schiphol Plaza, you can walk straight to railway station. Train tickets are available from the Ticket- and Service desks, which are situated close to the red/white-checked cube at Schiphol Plaza. You should get off at Rotterdam Central Station. You can walk to the Emma Hotel within 5 minutes from the Central Station or take a taxi from Station to the hotel.

You can also take a taxi from the airport directly to the Hotel, which costs approximately 95 Euro (but may even be higher!). No organised transportation will be available since the arrival times of each participant will be different. We suggest the cheapest and fastest form of transport, which is by train.

#### Accommodation and meals

Accommodation will be arranged in single rooms in Rotterdam and Amsterdam. The hotels in both cities will offer breakfast in the morning. Lunches and coffees and teas will be organised at each hospital during the day time.

#### **Departure from Schiphol-Amsterdam Airport on 10 October 2015**

The Dutch Orthopaedic Association and the Organising Committee are offering your accommodation and stay in the Netherlands from 05 October 2015 up to your departure from Amsterdam on 10 October 2015.
