How to get to Faro?

By plane The Faro Airport is a 15 min drive from the city center and 5 min from the University. Bus lines 14 and 16 make the connection to the center. (<http://www.ana.pt/en-US/Aeroportos/algarve/Faro>). Alternative flights may be found to the Lisbon Airport.

By train Faro has a central station in the city center connecting National and International cities - Sud Express (<https://www.cp.pt/passageiros/en/train-times/stations/faro>).

By car Faro is connected by freeway to Lisbon (A2) and to Seville (A22).
