#### Useful information

#### Arrival to Helsinki-Vantaa Airport, on 23rd of April, 2017

You may take any international or domestic flight to Helsinki-Vantaa airport, which is located 15 km outside the city. From the Helsinki-Vantaa airport, there are several transportation possibilities to downtown Helsinki. If traveling by train you should get off at the Rautatieasema station, which is the final station. You can also take a Finnair City Bus to downtown Helsinki which leaves from the ground floor level of the Helsinki-Vantaa airport. You can walk to Scandic Simonkenttä Hotel within 5 minutes. You can also take a taxi from the airport directly to the Hotel, which costs approximately  $40-50 \in$ . No organised transportation will be available since the arrival times of each participant will be different. We suggest the cheapest form of transport which is airport bus or train.

#### Accommodation and meals

Accommodation will be arranged in single rooms. The hotels in each city will offer breakfast in the morning. Lunches and coffees will be organised at each hospital during the day time.
