Dear Colleagues,

Hip arthroplasty is a very common procedure in orthopedic surgery nowadays. It is performed in all departments – sometimes by quite young surgeons – and the results are usually good. When everything goes well, the patient is happy and the surgeon is satisfied. But when something goes wrong, the surgeon must be ready to detect and face all the related complications and to offer to the patient the most effective and safest solutions to the problem. The aim of this course is to give basic, up-to-date guidelines on prophylaxis and the early diagnosis and treatment of hip arthroplasty complications. These may include joint instability, infection, DVT, periprosthetic fractures, leg length discrepancy, heterotopic ossification, nerve and vessel damage, and soft tissue problems.

Generous time will be set aside for discussion at the end of each session. Debates on difficult cases are also scheduled for the hottest topics. An entire session is dedicated for cases presentation by the audience and for the discussion on "what to do" together wit all the faculty. Participants in the course are warmly invited to bring their own cases for discussion and to submit them to the Scientific Committee before the beginning of the course or upon registration. Our hope is to stimulate very active participation in the course by all attendees.

Live surgery, showing techniques and tips for THA procedures, will be performed. Workshops organized by the sponsors will give participants the opportunity to try out some new devices from within the industry.

We are looking forward to meeting you all in Milan and to welcoming you to the Istituto Ortopedico Galeazzi IRCCS.
